WINES BY THE GLASS

1. Mark Tree Semillon Chardonnay (Australia)

£3.60 £5.25 £15.00

A stylish dry white wine from the two classic grape varieties of Australia. Light, crisp & Easy to drink on its own, or serve chilled with nibbles, chicken and seafood dishes.

2. Casa Roca Sauvignon Blanc Semillon (Chile)

£3.60 £5.25 £15.00

Attractive fruit on the nose with some citrus character, good tropical fruit flavours and fresh acidity from the sauvignon, balanced by roundness and weight from the Semillon.

3. Arcano Pinot Grigio (Italy)

£3.60 £5.25 £15.00

Made from rich, ripe grapes, fragrant, fresh, crisp with notes of tropical fruits.

4. Concha Y Toro Cabernet Blush (Chile)

£3.60 £5.25 £15.00

A lovely freshness can be tasted on the first sip, balanced sharpness on the palate with a pleasant and sweet final taste combining strawberry and raspberry notes.

5. Concha Y Toro Merlot (Chile)

£3.60 £5.25 £15.00

A delightful fruity Merlot, typical of the variety. Plums and red fruits come through on the palate, un-oaked to allow the fruit to show.

6. Mark Tree Merlot Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz (Australia)

£3.60 £5.25 £15.00

A warm, spicy red from selected vineyards. Unashamedly easy to drink, this smooth Australian red complements most hearty foods or is just as good solo.

7. Tesoro de los Andes Mendoza Malbec (Argentina)

£3.60 £5.25 £15.00

A great everyday drinking wine, this favourite is enticing and warm, with mixed bramble fruit on the nose. On the palate the wine shows a darker fruit character with more savoury overtones, generous and full with a soft rounded finish.

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WHITE WINES

- 16. Domaine Fontareche Vin du Pays D'Oc (France) £16.00**
An elegant, modern, floral wine, made from an unusual duo of vermentino and colombarid midi grapes, delicately reminiscent of celery on the nose with summery white angelica flavours and a clean finish.
- 17. Badassiere Sauvignon Pomerols Vin du Pays (France) £17.50**
Classic Sauvignon yellow colour with lively citrus fruit on the nose, the refreshing palate is defined by pure apple, lemon and stone fruit flavours, with medium body and a good long finish.
- 18. Musar Jeune (Lebanon) £18.00**
A youthful, unoaked wine from the Bekaa Valley. A crisp white blend of Viognier, Chardonnay and Vermentino that is rich, yet fresh, with aromas of pears, apricots, pineapples, floral notes and a hint of basil.
- 19. Gavi La Battistina (Italy) £18.50**
Made from the Cortese grape, aromatic, zesty nose with apple, lime and kiwi notes with a hint of minerality. Juicy, weighty fruit with a zippy, citric acid mouth watering feel creating a refreshing, satisfying finish.
- 20. Noel St Laurent Cotes du Rhone Blanc (France) £20.00**
Made from rich grapes, fragrant, fresh and crisp.
- 21. Pinot Blanc Klevner Reserve, Cave de Hunawihl (France) £23.00**
An award winning wine, a bright lemon-yellow in colour with a fresh, clean nose of white flowers and peaches. The palate is medium bodied, with ripe, stone fruit intensity and an elegant citrus length.

Natural, Organic White Wines

- 22. Chamonix Sauvignon Blanc Reserve (South Africa) £24.00**
Intense aroma of ripe apples and pears with a hint of herbs and tropical fruit. Bright steely in flavour, the grapefruit and spice sensations are buoyed by zesty acidity that refreshes the palate through to a smooth finish. (Advise decanting)
- 23. Domaine Moreau – Naudet – Chablis (France) £25.00**
24. Domaine Moreau – Naudet – Chablis (half bottle) £12.75
An entirely classic and pure Chablis nose with its green fruit, iodine and oyster shell nuances that are also reflected by the impressively concentrated, racy and intense flavours that are supported by a core of lemon infused acidity and excellent length (Advise decanting)
- 25. Domaine Breton – Vouvray La Dilettante (France) £25.00**
A wine with flavours of raw fruit, green apples and young lemons, meets dry limestone in this piercingly dry chenin blanc. Amazing verve and needle like precision. (Advise decanting)

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RED WINES

8. Noel St Laurent Cotes Du Rhone (France)

£17.50

From the warm, sunny sothern part of this famous area, a ripe fruit nose, spiciness on the palate with a soft finish.

9. Musar Jeune (Lebanon)

£18.00

A youthful, fruity and unoaked, wine from the Bekaa Valley. A blend of Cinsault, Syrah and cabernet sauvignon, it has rich blackcurrent / cherry fruit with hints of warming eastern spice.

10. El Coto Crinza Rioja (Spain)

£21.00

A soft attractive and well balanced rioja, successfully combines elegant fruit intensity with delicate creamy tones.

11. Kumeu River Pinot Noir (New Zealand)

£22.00

A wine that has aromas of pure ripe cherries and spice, on the palate it is dense and chewy with a silky texture starting to emerge.

12. Chateau Musar Hochar Pere et Fils (Lebanon)

£23.00

A blended wine of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault, Cairgnan and Grenache, its an intense and powerful vintage. Smooth, well rounded and spicy, with aromas of juicy black fruits, plums, dates, figs and a hint of thyme.(Advise decanting)

13. Chateau Cambon Récolte Beaujolais (France)

£23.00

Quite clear, deep purple red. Rustic scents, and flavours of fresh fruits and the farm, with a hint of liquorice.

Lingers long with nice, firm acidity.(Advise decanting)

14. Paxton AAA Shiraz Grenache (Australia)

£23.00

The Paxton AAA is a vibrant blend of 75% Shiraz and 25% Grenache, a fruit focused wine with lifted spice and red berry fragrance, with a palate of sweet berry fruit flavours and silky tannins. Smooth, even and very well balance. (Advise decanting)

15. Chateau Ollieux Romanis Cuvee Prestige (France)

£24.00

The low yielding vines aid in the production of wines with great purity of fruit and balance. This oak aged blend of Carignan, Grenache, Mouvedre and Syrah has concentrated flavours of black cherries, cocoa butter, liquorice and balsam along with silky tannins and a very smooth finish. (Advise decanting)

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ROSE WINES

26. El Coto Rioja Rosado (Spain)

£17.00

Blend of garnacha and tempranillo grapes which have been cold fermented in order to obtain the finest aromas, it shows freshness and touches of strawberries and raspberries.

27. Musar Jeune (Lebanon)

£18.00

A youthful, unoaked wine from the Bekaa Valley. A vibrant Cinsault rose, that is fresh, yet rounded. With aromas of strawberries, rose petals and summer berries, it is an ideal accompaniment to Mediterranean dishes.

SPARKLING WINES & CHAMPAGNE

28. Anna de Codornui Brut Cava (Spain) NV

£4.95

Both soft and fresh on the palate, displays the liveliness and femininity that its name suggests. The Chardonnay that has been blended with Cava's classic grape trio highlights the fresh floral and fruit aromas of the aging process. The balance between acidity and residual sugar give it an elegant, fruity and gentle taste, making ideal for Brut lovers.

29. Louis Dornier et Fils Brut

£25.00

30. Louis Dornier et Fils Brut (Half Bottle)

£15.00

Very stylish with a pronounced biscuity flavour and a fine elegant bouquet.

31. Moet et Chandon Brut Imperial NV

£30.00

Aromas of tropical fruits, sweet melon, buttery brioche and creamy dried red fruit essences. A palate that shows great complex flavours of ripe stone-fruits, white berries, white chocolate and subdued vanilla. Toasted nuts, fruit flesh, silky and sublime, the intriguing palate of this exceptional wine culminates in a glorious and unforgettable finish

32. Piper-Heidsieck Cuvée Brut NV

£40.00

33. Piper-Heidsieck Cuvée Brut NV (Half Bottle)

£22.50

A fresh, medium-bodied style, this shows finesse, with notes of apple, peach, ruby grapefruit, vanilla and toast. The refined texture and vibrant structure keep this focused and lingering, with fine length.

34. Taittinger Brut Reserve NV

£40.00

Perhaps the lightest and most elegant of the Grand Marque Champagnes. An intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance from a predominance of Chardonnay.
